1. PERFORMANCE MEASURES
Provide guidance to the development and use of performance measures consistent with agency, business, and customer requirements. The resulting performance measures should be suitable for evaluating contractor as well as agency performance, and for guiding and evaluating the team management processes. To achieve the measures should be readily understood, measurable.



2. ANALYTICAL TOOLS AND TECHNOLOGIES FOR COST MANAGEMENT
Identify, develop and demonstrate application of analytical tools and techniques to support team management, resource allocation strategies. These tools should be suitable for planning, program, and project level analysis. The tools should include both labor and other resource costs and activity forecasts, as appropriate. The tools should include provisions for benefit-cost analysis. The tools also require the measurement, economic valuation, performance evaluation, and evaluation of their effectiveness.

3. SUPPLEMENTAL DATA TO DRIVE THE ANALYTICAL TOOLS
Provide guidance to the development to collection of supplemental data required to drive team management analytical tools such as:

- Cost (such as, e.g., labor rates)
- Risk (such as, e.g., equipment or transportation vehicles)

- Board of Directors resolution stating their support for asset management
- AASHTO will convene a national summit on asset management (FHWA, APTA, ASCE, etc.)
- AASHTO will form a national partnership
- Establish Asset Management Institute to ensure sustainability
 - i. Maintain Asset Management Guide
 - ii. Develop an asset management analysis approach for the next reauthorization's Bottom Line Report that supports federal investment
 - iii. Maintain Asset Management web site
 - iv. Form funding commitment
