If you have purchased your eligible equipment from a non-participating retailer, please send the following documents to: Lawn Care Rebate Program, 850 Barret Avenue, Louisville, KY 40204.

- Original lawn equipment purchase receipt from area retailer qualifies for a Standard Rebate without trade-in. (Photocopies will not be accepted.)
- Original notarized green voucher from a recycling center (if you traded in a used gas appliance for new eligible equipment) qualifies for a Bonus Rebate. (Photocopies not accepted.)
- Proof of Jefferson County residency. (Photocopy of driver's license.)
- Amount of rebate for which you qualify.

The Lawn Care Rebate Program is offering the following rebate options:

Electric Blower/Vac‡	\$15	\$30
Electric Blower/Vac (2000 watts, 200 mph force + 2 year warranty)	\$15	\$30
Replacement Batteries for trimmer & blower/vac	\$10	\$15

Did You Know?

Operating a typical (4HP) gasoline-powered lawn mower for one hour produces the same amount of smog-forming hydrocarbons as driving an average car almost 200 miles under typical driving conditions.

Lawn Care Rebate Procedures

To participate in the Lawn Care Rebate Program, you must comply with the following guidelines:

- Be a resident of Louisville Metro/Jefferson County, KY and provide a copy of your driver's license (or proof of residency) to the participating retailer or when submitting your mail-in rebate request.
- Take your old gasoline-powered lawn equipment (drained of all fluids) to one of the two recycling centers listed below. Receive a green notarized voucher, and present it when you purchase eligible equipment at a participating retailer* to receive your Bonus Rebate on the spot! If you don't have anything to trade in, you can still receive a Standard Rebate just by purchasing eligible equipment at a participating retailer! In both cases, your rebate amount will be deducted from the retail price.
- If you are purchasing your eligible equipment at a non-participating retailer, take your old gas-powered trade-in equipment to one of the recycling centers listed below, and use the form on the back of this flyer to request a Bonus or Standard Rebate. You should receive your rebate within 60 days. The following recycling centers accept trade-in gas equipment Tuesday through Saturday, 10:00 to 5:00 p.m., March 2 through September 30. (Recycling of gasoline-powered appliances is not available from October 1 through February 28.)
 - Metro Recycling Center #1, 595 Hubbards Lane
 - Metro Recycling Center #2, 7219 Dixie Highway

*Fluids drained from gas equipment may be delivered to the Haz Bin Household Hazardous Materials Collection Center, 7501 Grade Lane, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Wednesdays or Saturdays.

All eligible equipment must be purchased new or factory reconditioned.
 †Trade-in equipment must be gas-powered equipment or replacement batteries, similar to the new eligible electric, reel, or battery-powered equipment that will be purchased with a Bonus Rebate. The equipment should be taken to one of the recycling centers listed above (10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday, March 2 through September 30) before you purchase your new equipment. Some participating retailers accept replacement batteries for trade/recycling when a new battery is purchased.
 ‡ Blower/Vac includes leaf blowers that have a leaf vacuum function or attachment.
 § Participating Retailers give the rebates up front, as dollars off purchase price. They are listed on the website: www.apcd.org.
